### **Faith Formation News**

Hosana! Hosana to the King! Welcome to Holy The holiest week of our Church year. Thursday we enter the Triduum, the most sacred days of the Church year: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. I invite and encourage all of you to clear your calendars and take part in all the liturgies this week! We don't just remember the way of Jesus passion, but we deeply remember and engage in the last week of Jesus' life. Holy Thursday liturgy will be here at St Philip at 6:00 pm. Good Friday liturgy of the Passion/veneration of the Cross is the center of the Triduum. We always read the Passion according to John on Good Friday. Good Friday liturgy is so deep and powerful. After the reading of the Passion we adore the Cross, we hear the most ancient prayers of the faithful that the Church has, and we receive Communion. There is no Mass celebrated on Good Friday. But we do receive Communion from consecrated hosts from Holy Thursday Mass. There is not the official liturgy of Good Friday here at St Philip, St Agnes in Marion has that liturgy. The Easter Vigil is the vigil of vigils. It is the Church at its very BEST! Don't miss it. Yes, it is long. But oh, will you be blessed. St Philip does not have the vigil Mass this year, St Agnes in Marion has that liturgy.

This past weekend I went to the Chosen: The Last Supper part I. One scene showed Jesus riding a colt, a baby donkey into Jerusalem. The people were jubilant and yelling "Hosana" while waying their palm branches. They believed Jesus was the Messiah, coming to conquer the Romans and set them free from Roman control. Jesus indeed comes to set us free but not from Roman control but from sin and death. I was moved by the way the director and actors portrayed this scene. It has moved me to be more engaged this Holy Week and to deeply remember Jesus during the Triduum.

One way to engage is to reflect on the scripture readings for Palm Sunday. The first and second readings are incredible. We will read the Passion of Jesus Christ according to Luke this year on Palm Sunday. Each day this week the scripture readings will lead you on the journey with Jesus. Put yourself next to Jesus as he walks the way to Calvery.

Easter Sunday: A reminder that St Philip will have an Easter Sunday Mass this year! Mass on Easter Sunday April 20 is at 10 am. Let us gather the parish family together to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
