### **A SEMINARIAN**

A seminarian is a Catholic man who is discerning the Lord's call to the priesthood. To become a seminarian he has to have a bachelor's degree in a related field, such as theology or English. He goes to seminary for four to eight years, depending on having a college degree or not and serves as a Deacon for six months to a year before being ordained. He must be unmarried male between the ages of 25 and 63.

Currently there are 20 men from our diocese studying at seminary in Mundelein IL. The cost of attending seminary over an eight year period can cost over \$500,000. Our diocese supports our seminarians with proceeds from the Our Shepherds our Future Campaign. Go to website [The Knights of Columbus at St. Philip Neri also contribute to seminarians and currently are sponsoring Patrick Truskowski on his journey to priesthood. Patrick is enrolled in First year Theology at Mundelein Seminary. He is a graduate of West Catholic H.S. and attended Aquinas College in Grand Rapids.
