Blessed Michael J. McGivney

Michael Joseph McGivney (b. Aug. 12, 1852 d. Aug. 14, 1890) was an Irish-American Catholic priest in New Haven, Conn. He founded the Knights of Columbus at a local parish as a mutual aid and fraternal organization to help struggling immigrants and their families. He was born to Irish immigrant parents, and the eldest of 13 children. In 1868, at age of 16, he entered the seminary and was ordained a priest at St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore, Maryland on December 22, 1877. In 1996, the cause for canonization of Fr. McGivney began and on March 15, 2008, Pope Benedict XVI recognized McGivney's heroic virtue, thus declaring him as "Venerable." In May of 2015, a miracle attributed to Fr. McGivney and in May of 2020, another miracle was attributed to him by Pope Francis. In October of 2020, the beatification Mass of Fr. McGivney was celebrated at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford, Connecticut.

Prayer for Canonization

God, Our Father, Protector of the poor and defender of the widow and orphan, you called your priest, Father Michael J. McGivney, to be an apostle of Christian family life and to lead the young to generous service of their neighbor. Though the example of his life in virtue, may we follow your son, Jesus Christ for closely fulfilling his commandment of charity and building up his body, which is the church. Let the inspiration of your servant prompt us to greater confidence in you love so that we may continue his work for caring for the needy and the outcast. We humbly ask that you glorify your humble servant Father McGivney on earth according to the design of your holy will. Through his intercession grant the favor that I now present through Christ our Lord. Amen.
