Again, this week in the Gospel we hear a very familiar story, Martha, and Mary. The balance in life between preparing, working, and remembering who we belong to while we engage in our busyness. Do we take time to listen at the feet of Jesus? The offering of true hospitality is what we hear in both the Old Testament reading as well as the Gospel.

True and authentic hospitality comes with time a of preparation while keeping in mind our Lord. Upon the arrival of our guest, we focus of our attention and time on them in the name of Jesus. My best friend Beverly is Italian. She is a great cook. I know she takes great care in shopping, in preparing ahead of time, in putting on a fantastic meal when I come for dinner. If this is a celebration for many people, she will often set the table beautifully the night before so that is done. She does this out of love for me, and all who are coming. The small details show her love for me and the other guests. I also know she is a woman of great faith. She has an incredible prayer time every day. She participates in the sacramental life of the Church. I know Beverly prays for me daily.

This is balance I believe Jesus is asking us for in Gospel today. To put Martha and Mary together: we must prepare for life, we go to our jobs, we take care of our families and guests. We also sit at the feet of Jesus in prayer, in receiving the Eucharist every week (the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ), and when we celebrate Reconciliation.

I could really relate to what Jesus says to Martha, "You are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of one thing." Lately with the changes here at St Philip Neri, the closing of St Anne, and the loss of our Sunday Mass, I have been worried. With all that is going on in my personal life I have noticed I have become more anxious. This is the time where my faith must be stronger than the anxiety and worry. I repeat the great phrase from St Padre Pio in my mind, "Pray, Hope and don't Worry." There is a call in my heart to rest at the feet of Jesus. To trust in God's plan for me and for the parish of St Philip Neri.
