### **Eucharistic Food For Thought**

“I have heard that the Eucharist forgives sins. Is it really Necessary to go to Reconciliation before receiving Jesus in the Eucharist?”

All People should attend Reconciliation at least once a year or as often as is necessary if someone has committed a mortal sin. The Eucharist does forgive venial sins, the smaller sins. When we begin Mass, we pray a Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass where we confess our sins to God and each other. In this rite, we ask God to forgive our sins and by receiving the Eucharist, we are united to the one Body of Christ and His holy Church.

However, if you have committed a mortal sin, it is imperative that you go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation prior to receiving the Eucharist. While venial sins weaken our relationship with God, mortal sins break our relationship with God. For this reason, we must first restore our relationship with God and the Church and be reconciled with God before receiving Communion. In celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we are strengthened and revitalized to continue on our journey in faith. Indeed, Reconciliation brings about “spiritual resurrection.” Read more about Reconciliation in Article 4 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church:CCC1422-1493.
