This weekend we focus on The Most Holy Trinity. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit, a community of love. This is a living relationship that we are invited into. A relationship that we are asking to foster, to spend time with and in. A relationship in which we call upon God the Father, or Jesus the Son and Redeemer, or the Holy Spirit, the guide, the Advocate.

What does it take to live in a relationship with the Trinity? Time: Yes, we must take the time alone, in quiet to listen and be with the Trinity. Turn off all the devices. Sit alone in quiet. Breathe in the Most Holy Trinity. Ask the Trinity to come, to take over your mind and heart. And just be. In your world you may need to adapt! Then turn off the devices, sit with your children and ask them to also open their hearts to the Trinity: God the Father, Jesus the Son and the love of the Holy Spirit. Sit for one minute, then two minutes and teach your family to call upon the Trinity. But take the time and do it!

Share your life with the Trinity! In our earthy relationships we share our joys and sorrows with each other. Especially sharing with those close to us. When we share our lives with each other we become known. When we share with the Most Holy Trinity they offer us the divine love, acceptance and peace we seek. We do not travel through this life alone. The Trinity is always with us. The Trinity is always seeking relationships with us. This Divine relationship is the relationship that brings wholeness and true joy, true love and the courage to endure the times of suffering.
