Faith Formation News

This is the last weekend in June, so this is my last article on the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Pastoral Letter by Cardinal Thomas Collins: Heart Speaks to Heart. A copy of the Pastoral letter is still available in the back of the Church. Towards the end of the letter there is a section on Some Practical Suggestions for Devotion to the Sacred Heart.

I would like to go through some of these suggestions. The first one that he speaks about is **Making a Holy Hour, prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.** My experience is that when I commit to take the time to sit quietly before the Blessed Sacrament on a regular basis it makes a difference in my relationships with others and with our Lord, and it influences the way I view life. I encourage you to make time to spend an hour with our Lord in front of the Blessed Sacrament. **Read a portion of one of the Gospels every day.** To help us encounter Jesus in his Most Sacred Heart we read his teachings and stories his miracles each day. Take time to read and engage in the Living Word of God. Cardinal Collins gives seven suggestions on all on pages 17 and 18 of the Pastoral Letter.

In September Pope Francis will release a new document on the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Pope Francis believes we need to renew our devotion to the Sacred Heart in these trying times. It also marks the 350th anniversary of the first apparition of the Sacred Heart to St Margaret Mary Alacoque. I am looking forward to reading that document as well. I pray that Cardinal Collins Pastoral Letter: Heart Speaks to Heart has been helpful to you. I pray your summertime is joyful and fruitful in the Holy Spirit.
