This weekend we celebrate Pentecost. We hear about tongues of fire and a strong driving wind: The images of the Holy Spirit. 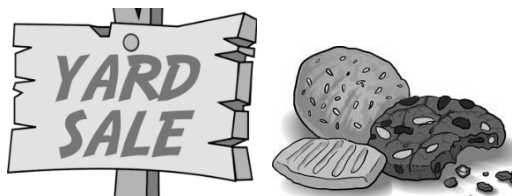
