Faith Formation

Our Bishop has announced that there will be a diocesan-wide pastoral planning process entitled "Rooted in Christ." Please read the attached letter from Bishop Walkowiak. The first phase of the process has already begun around the diocese. This past week a representative of the Meitler Group came to St Philip Neri.

I would like to share with all of you how that meeting went. First, he and I sat in my office and talked. He has several questions about the parish and parish life here at St Philip Neri. I did not know he was going to ask these questions. However, I have served here for 16 years and believe I have a good sense of The People of God that make up this parish. We continue to try to live out our calling as disciples of Jesus Christ in the midst of the changes that has happened especially in the last two years. Yet we remain strong in our commitment to forming our young people in faith, outreach to the poor, and community life. I spoke about all these wonderful ministries to the representative.

He and I then went on a tour of the offices, rectory and Church. As I showed him each room, I talked about what takes place in those rooms. It truly is amazing what takes place here at St Philip. Blessings to all of you who give of your time, talent and treasure to live out your faith life and to help others learn or grown in their faith life. We also have an outstanding staff at this parish.

People of God of St Anne, I did not forget about you. I did speak to the representative about St Anne. Sharing about how you all treat each other like "family." You may be small, but you are mighty in faith. We talked about the way St Anne was closed. That I did not think it was done in a proper manner, as did many of us. That the Church building is being cared for and maintained. There is a cemetery also, across the street from the Church, that is being maintained as well. We have had several funerals there as well as one wedding.

Please continue to pray for this pastoral planning process. Please take the time to read the bishop's letter. I will keep you all updated as the process moves along.
